A. When the organization was formed + brief history

• No information was found describing when the organization was formed. Police rounded up the group in Sao Paulo in March of 2008.¹ One of the three arrested, João Mendonça Alves, was found dead in his jail cell while awaiting trial.² The other two (Marripersad Jhingoeri and Mahinderparkash Chuttoo) were from Suriname.³ They were released after the death of João Mendonça Alves because the only witnesses that were left to testify were police, and a judge found that a conviction based purely on police testimony was unconstitutional.⁴

B. Types of illegal activities engaged in,

 - Drug trafficking
- b. Specific detail: types of illicit trafficking activities engaged in
 - Trafficked cocaine from Colombia and Bolivia disguised as truck batteries and transported over land to Sao Paulo, where the drugs were then to be shipped to the Netherlands and Poland.⁵

 - They had warehouses in the port of Santos.⁹
- ii. Key routes
 - There is some confusion in the reports about where the drugs originated from, whether Colombia, Bolivia, or both.
 - The drugs were transported overland in trucks.

d. Transportation

- i. Land
 - Trucks
- ii. Sea
 - The drugs were to be shipped by boat to Netherlands and Poland.
- iii. Air
 - The gang also flew drugs out of the Viracopos International Airport¹¹
- iv. Intermodal container
 - No information, but it is likely that the shipments would have gone in containers.

G. Trafficking Methods and Modalities

- a. Corruption
 - No information, but the death of João Mendonça Alves was considered suspicious and prison authorities were investigated for complicity.¹²
- b. Concealment
 - The drugs were packaged into large truck batteries after being wrapped in a lead covering to thwart x-ray inspections.¹³
- c. Deception
 - Information not found.
- d. Circumvention (avoiding border entry points)
 - No information about avoiding entry points. It appears that they relied on concealing the drugs to get them through entry points.

M. Evaluations

- a. Strengths
 - Two of the three arrested were acquitted and the third died before he could be brought to trial, and because of this the larger network was not uncovered.
 - The suspicious death of Mendonça Alves and the acquittal of the Surinamese may indicate that pressure was applied to police and judicial authorities.
- b. Weaknesses and vulnerabilities
 - The gang lost a very large shipment of cocaine (over a ton).
 - It lost one of its members involved in logistics.
 - It lost control of its warehouses.
 - It had its method of concealing cocaine discovered.
 - It had its destination markets uncovered.
